

## **Program Management Services for Frankford Transportation Center - Philadelphia, PA**

The Frankford terminal is the eastern terminus of the Market-Frankford Elevated Line and the home to 14 bus lines and Route 66 trolley. The purpose of this project was to construct a new modern transportation center building and a four-level, 1,000-space parking garage. The new center includes elevators, escalators, climate-controlled waiting areas, a customer information center, SEPTA sales office and a SEPTA police station. Construction was performed while maintaining access for the 50,000 riders who pass through the facility daily. The project entails the program management of five (5) construction contracts. Garg provided *construction inspection services* for this project.



**Additional project tasks included:**

- Field Inspection services to ensure compliance with the construction contract requirements
- Inspecting and testing of all materials
- Monitoring of project schedule and contractor's CPM bar chart schedule, environmental compliance, construction quality and cost control
- Reporting to SEPTA on the status of the program
- Program Management Plan (PMP)
- Change Orders
- Punch list inspections
